- We operate a walk-in food bank and a home delivery program.
- We provide groceries to 5,600-6200 customers a month.



2008 Statistics

- 80,504 people visited the food bank
- 2,333,292 pounds of food were distributed
- Volunteers gave 25,664 hours of their time

How do we respond to special needs?

- We offer "no-cook" bags of groceries for our customers who do not have access to cooking facilities.
- We distribute hygiene items like soap, shampoo, band-aids and lotion.
- We offer baby products like formula, diapers and baby food
